The **Drinking Water Internships Program** continued its commitment to train Indigenous youth and young adults to become certified water treatment operators, in order to provide safe, clean drinking water for future generations.

This past year DWP celebrated:

- 11 Internship graduates
- 19,800 collective hours of Internship training
- **36** provincially-recognized certifications earned

The **Schools Water Program** engaged Indigenous students, from K-12, to showcase pathways to careers in aquatic science and drinking water sectors.

This past year SWP delivered:

- Programing that earned high school students 35 credits
- Its first-ever partnerships in western Canada, with workshops in Northwest Territories (Déline First Nation), Alberta (Fort Chipewyan), and British Columbia (with Boston Bar First Nation and S wxwú7mesh Úxwumixw [Squamish Nation])
- 32 water science workshops

The **Environmental Water Program** worked to recruit, support, and train Indigenous youth and adults to gain employment in water resource stewardship.

This past year EWP completed:

- The successful restoration of a 170m<sup>2</sup> walleye spawning habitat with Sagamok Anishnawbek
- The delivery of 24 workshops
- 1,221 hours of in-field training
